ORDER 2013 (No. 3)

AN BORD PLEANÁLA (hereinafter referred to as “the Board”) has on the 1st day of September, 2014 made a confirmation order confirming the above-named compulsory purchase order without modification as respects the land described in the First Schedule hereto. The said order, as so confirmed, authorises Mayo County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Local Authority”) to acquire the said land compulsorily.

The order also authorises the Local Authority to extinguish the public and private rights of way described in the Second Schedule hereto, by order made by them after they have acquired the said land.

An application for judicial review of the decision of the Board under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986) may be made to the High Court within eight weeks of the date of publication of this notice in accordance with section 50 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as substituted and amended).
